


Level 3 Diploma or Extended Diploma in Performing and Production Arts - Acting

ONE - TWO YEARS

What you'll learn

You have the option to choose a one-year Diploma that's the equivalent of 1.5 A-Levels, or a two-year Extended Diploma that's the equivalent to 3 ALevels. Over each of these courses we'll equip you with new skills and techniques to develop as a performer, across a wide range of performances throughout the curriculum. Each course will give you experience in acting techniques, vocal skills, National Theatre connections, drama improvisation, musical theatre, singing, physical theatre, classical theatre, contemporary theatre, movement skills, stage combat and radio techniques.



What you'll need

We ask all our applicants to have five GCSE's between grades four to nine, ideally these will include music, maths and english. We also want you to demonstrate a passion for performing arts. If you apply, we'll invite you to an interview and audition.

How are you assessed?

You are at the centre of your assessment. While we assess you on rehearsals, practical performance and written coursework, in the lead up to that we make sure to give you a complete brief for each project with a clear outline and it's content. You will need to put in some time for independent research, and rehearsals towards performances and projects. But, your tutors bring with them a wealth of industry knowledge, so they'll be with you every step of the way for advice and guidance - and to bring out the best potential performer in you!


