

### **What you'll learn**

Over a one-year course we will equip you with new skills and techniques to develop in music, performance and production arts across a wide range of performances throughout the curriculum.

There are no formal requirements for entry into this course, but we ask that you have a reasonable command of written and spoken English, as well as basic maths skills.

We'd also like you to have an interest in either music, performance or production arts. If you apply, you'll be invited to an interview, audition and workshops.

### **How are you assessed?**


This course is modular, so each assessment will involve performances and coursework. While we assess you on rehearsals, practical performance and written coursework, in the lead up to that we make sure to give you a complete brief for each project with a clear outline and its content. You will need to put in some time for independent research, and rehearsals towards performances and projects. But, your tutors bring with them a wealth of industry knowledge, so they'll be with you every step of the way for advice and guidance - and to bring out the best potential performer in you!
