


## Level 3 Diploma or Extended Diploma in Music Performance and Production

## ONE - TWO YEARS

### What you'll learn

You have the option to choose a one-year Diploma that's the equivalent of 1.5 A-Levels, or a two-year Extended Diploma that's the equivalent to 3 A-Levels. Over each of these courses we'll equip you with the new skills and techniques for playing instruments and performing as an ensemble. You'll learn MIDI sequencing using Logic Pro and how to mix, master and produce your own music using notation software. Along with that, you'll also gain valuable knowledge of music in theory, harmony, the music industry, technology and sound engineering.



### What you'll need

We ask all our applicants to have five GCSE's between grades four to nine, ideally these will include music, maths and english. We also want you to demonstrate a passion for music and have the ability to play at least one instrument. If you apply, we'll invite you to an interview and audition.

### How are you assessed?

Within your group you'll be assigned different projects throughout the year so you can get to grips with each aspect of the project - whether that be in performance or vital, behind-the-scenes, jobs to keep the show going. These projects include creating an EP for online release, performing original and cover songs as a band in local gig-venues, and, finally, becoming a sound engineer for drama and dance productions. These industry led courses will allow you to train in our Music Mac-Labs as well as work in our state of the art recording studios.
