### What you'll learn

Over a one-year course we'll equip you with new skills and techniques to develop as a performer, across a wide range of performances throughout the curriculum. Each course will give you experience in acting techniques, movement skills, musical theatre, devising projects, singing, production arts skills, and performance workshops. These are all designed to bring out your potential confidence and performance ability.



### What you'll need

We ask all our applicants to have five GCSE's above grade three, ideally these will include music, maths and english. Or a Level One Diploma in Performing Arts. We also want you to demonstrate a passion for performing arts. If you apply, we'll invite you to an interview, audition and a workshop.

### How are you assessed?

This course is modular, so each assessment will involve performances and coursework. While we assess you on rehearsals, practical performance and written coursework, in the lead up to that we make sure to give you a complete brief for each project with a clear outline and it's content. You will need to put in some time for independent research, and rehearsals towards performances and projects. But, your tutors bring with them a wealth of industry knowledge, so they'll be with you every step of the way for advice and guidance - and to bring out the best potential performer in you!
